



## **AWARENESS OF SAFEGUARDING - FAA LEVEL 1 AWARD (RQF)**

### **Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility.**

This qualification will provide an understanding of safeguarding which can be used in a workplace, activity group or any instance where a person comes into contact with children or adults at risk. The course is also suitable for all parents and carers. The qualification provides learners with the knowledge to identify a safeguarding concern, record disclosure and report to the appropriate person.

## **PRINCIPLES OF SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN, YOUNG PEOPLE OR VULNERABLE ADULTS - FAA LEVEL 3 AWARD (RQF)**

Safeguarding is how we can protect children, young people and vulnerable adults from abuse or neglect by the actions, or lack of actions, of another person. In order to safeguard and protect persons from abuse or neglect we need to learn how to identify vulnerable individuals and take necessary steps to stop abuse and neglect.

Everyone has the right to be safe and live without the fear of abuse, neglect or exploitation and this course aims to teach you how to recognise the signs of abuse and neglect and what actions you can take to stop this from happening and occurring again in the future. Abuse, neglect and exploitation can occur anywhere and by anyone, quite often being a person of trust.

This course is designed for all persons, not matter the field that they are directly involved in, to give them the tools and knowledge to make a difference to a vulnerable person's life. It will also let the practitioner reporting the abuse know how they can safeguard themselves in every day work, while seeking help and reporting the incident identified.

This course is perfect for those, who work involves high responsibility for safeguarding within organisation, such as family support workers, social workers, care workers, Police, health care workers including GP or those who wish to become DSL.

This course will also include extra guidance related to safeguarding specific to the student's job-roles, including health-care professionals (NHS) and Designated Safeguarding Leads (DSL's) . The classroom-based training will include local information related to Rochdale Council area.
